Solar Eclipse

After much anticipation, the eclipse is almost here! As a building (K-6) we will be going out to the playground from 1:00-1:15 with our NASA approved solar glasses to observe the event. Extensive training has been covered by the classroom teachers on all safety procedures. If you would prefer your child does not go outside for this event, please contact the Rosehill office and we will have them watch a live stream inside the building. Students are allowed, and encouraged, to bring a hat to school tomorrow to wear outside for the eclipse. I do want to stress that we will be enforcing a zero tolerance approach tomorrow and will have any student that removes their glasses without adult instruction sent inside for the remainder of the event. With the support of all staff and parents attending, I feel very confident it will be a successful experience for all children.

Also of note, all lunch times will be moved up 10 minutes tomorrow so the school can be properly situated on the playground by 1:00 p.m.
